He publishes *Americans Speak Out About the Arts* and produces the two premier economic studies of the arts—*Arts & Economic Prosperity* and *Creative Industries*. Randy led the development of *The National Arts Index* and the *National Arts Policy Roundtable*. Earlier in his career, Randy collaborated with the President's Committee on the Arts and the Humanities to create *Coming Up Taller* and with the U.S. Department of Justice to produce the *YouthARTS Project*. A sought-after speaker, he regularly appears in the news media including the *Wall Street Journal, The New York Times*, and on *C-SPAN, CNN, CNBC*, and *NPR*.
