## **Business and Community Leader Bobby Jenkins Recognized at 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Richard W. Weekley Public Policy Leadership Award Dinner in Austin**

AUSTIN – On Wednesday, December 11, the Texas Business Leadership Council (TBLC) recognized Austin business and community leader, Bobby Jenkins with their annual honor, [the Richard W. The Award was created in 2014 to celebrate the organization’s 20th anniversary and acknowledges the invaluable contributions made by business leaders in developing sound public policy for the benefit of the State of Texas and its citizens.

Bobby Jenkins is the President of ABC Home & Commercial Services, a Texas-based, family-owned company founded in 1949, with offices in several Texas locations, including Austin, San Antonio, College Station, Corpus Christi, and the Rio Grande Valley. Currently, Bobby Jenkins serves as Chair of the Central Texas Regional Mobility Authority, the Association of Former Students at Texas A&M University, the Sudden Unexplained Death in Childhood Foundation, and the Professional Pest Management Alliance; Co-founder and Board Member of Recognize Good; Board Member of Citizens Against Lawsuit Abuse, the Alzheimer’s Texas Association, E3 Alliance, the Moss Pieratt Foundation, the Friends of the ABC Kite Festival Foundation, United Way, and Austin Gives with the Austin Chamber of Commerce; Co-chair of Caritas of Austin’s capital campaign; Trustee for the College For All Texans Foundation and the Better Business Bureau Education Foundation; and as an Executive Committee Member for the Texas Business Leadership Council.

Regarding the award, Jenkins said, “I’m honored by this recognition, and appreciate that this Award stems from the simple idea of giving back.
